On Saturday, July 8, 2017 at approximately 9:10 p.m., the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department, Wisconsin State Patrol, City of Delafield, and Village of Chenequa Police Departments, along with the City of Delafield, Town of Delafield, Lake Country, Pewaukee, Western Lakes, Stone Bank and Hartland Fire Departments responded to a multiple vehicle crash involving a pedestrian on I-94 Eastbound just west of Cushing Park Road in the City of Delafield.

During the investigation, it was determined that a minivan was stopped on the shoulder of eastbound I-94 with a flat tire. A passing motorist pulled over to assist the occupants of the minivan. While in the process of changing the tire, a vehicle traveling eastbound on I-94 struck the minivan and the motorist who was assisting the occupants of the minivan.

Four vehicles and one pedestrian were involved in the crash. A 48-year-old male was transported to Aurora Hospital in Summit where he was pronounced dead. A 56-year-old female was transported to Waukesha Memorial Hospital with non-life threatening injuries. An 11-year-old child was transported to Children's Hospital with non-life threatening injuries. The operator of the striking vehicle, a 37-year-old male, was transported to Aurora Hospital in Summit with non-life threatening injuries.

I-94 Westbound was closed for about 2 hours and I-94 Eastbound was closed for about 6 hours while the Waukesha County Sheriff's Crash Reconstruction Unit investigated the crash.

This incident remains under investigation by the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department.
