You must complete the item requirements needed to earn a Bronze Pin, at least 10 points, to earn a Silver Pin, at least 12 points, or to earn a Gold Pin, at least 15 points. For each rank you must complete five of the first seven item requirements. These are of importance in the careers of all successful members. No more than one point may be taken for any number. The requirements listed for each item are the minimum number, are well within the reach of every ambitious 4-H member. Try to build your record by completing many items rather than just the minimum number.
