WHAT?

Shotgun is a Countywide Project part of the Waukesha County 4-H Shooting Sports Project.

WHO?

Open to any regular 4-H member, 12 and up to one year past high school. Cloverbuds cannot participate in this project.

WHERE?

Waukesha Gun Club, N22W23170 Watertown Road

WHEN?

Every Tuesday between May 2nd and June 27th
6:30 - 7:30 PM

DETAILS

The cost to shoot is \$7.00. You **MUST** supply your own shotgun, eye, and ear protection, and ammunition. That night's shells may be purchased each night at the clubhouse before shooting. FAIR INFO

Youth can use an officially signed score sheet from any 4-H practice as an entry at the Waukesha County Fair. Flash will need to know by email the Tuesday (1 week) before the next practice they want to do it at, so Flash can have the paperwork available. He will then send an email confirming the date and shoot. The more advance notice, the better. Youth cannot obtain a scored sheet without this advance notice.
