It may be necessary to consult other sources such as Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Floodway or Flood Insurance Rate maps, watershed studies, or topographic maps to determine regional flood All shoreland delineations on these maps are subject to change based on navigability determinations by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and others. Wetland information is taken from the 2015 DNR/SEWRPC Wisconsin Wetland Inventory Update. Environmental Corridor information is taken from the 2015 SEWRPC Inventory with some refinements based upon recent specific survey information and 2015 aerial photo interpretation. Wetlands and Environmental Corridors were captured from aerial photography. Further field investigation may be required to determine presence or boundary of Wetlands or Environmental Corridor.
