Community-based Mental Health and Substance Use Psychosocial Rehabilitation Services

CCS Is Different Than Traditional Outpatient Treatment.

It is designed to assist an individual whose mental health symptoms may impair their ability to function and/or participate in daily living.

What is CCS and What Do We Offer?

- Service Facilitation
- Screening and Assessment
- Service Planning
- Diagnostic Evaluations
- Psychotherapy
- Individual and/or Family Psychoeducation
- Substance Use Treatment
- Peer Support
- Physical Health Monitoring
- Medication Management
- Individual Skill Development and Enhancement
- Wellness Management and Recovery/Recovery Support Services
- Employment-related Skills Training and Support

Program Eligibility

- A child or adolescent who is a resident of Waukesha County.
- Current Medicaid funding or Medicaid eligible
- A child or adolescent who has a need for a more intensive delivery of services than traditional outpatient services.
- A child or adolescent with mental health and/or substance use issues whose symptoms interfere with one or more major life activities, as identified by the CCS assessment.
- A child and family who are willing to participate in services to assist with identified needs.



Program Steps

OUTREACH:

Family receives an outreach call from outreach specialist. Briefly discuss program and eligibility.

MEETING & APPLICATION:

Child or adolescent and their parent or guardian, meet with a service facilitator to review the program and complete an application.

ASSESSMENT:

Within 30 days of the application, additional meetings are scheduled to complete a functional screen and comprehensive assessment to identify strengths, needs, and priorities for services and treatment. A recovery team is then identified and formed.

RECOVERY PLAN:

Within 30 days of application, the recovery team convenes to determine recovery goals. The service facilitator prepares a recovery plan. This plan outlines all of the treatment and services that will be provided.

MONITOR AND RE-EVALUATION:

Services outlined in the recovery plan will continue to be coordinated by the service facilitator. Progress is reevaluated at least every 6 months by the client and the recovery team.
