MODIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION 2025 BUDGET AND AUTHORIZE
THE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT THE STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT
PROGRAM AWARD

WHEREAS, Waukesha County recognizes the importance of enhancing its cybersecurity infrastructure to protect vital information systems; and

WHEREAS, Waukesha County has been awarded \$43,084 in federal Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funding through the Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs – Division of Emergency Management’s State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program, to fund advanced cybersecurity measures; and

WHEREAS, this grant was not anticipated nor included in the 2025 County budget; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be utilized to upgrade detection and automated response systems, integrate advanced sensors, and support staff training on new technologies.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS the Department of Administration – End User Technology Fund is authorized to accept \$43,084 in grant funds from the Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs – Division of Emergency Management’s State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program.



FISCAL NOTE

MODIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION 2025 BUDGET AND AUTHORIZE
THE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT THE STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT
PROGRAM AWARD

This ordinance authorizes the Department of Administration – End User Technology Fund (EUTF) to accept \$43,084 of federal Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funding provided through the Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs – Division of Emergency Management’s State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program. The ordinance also modifies the department’s 2025 budget to increase operating expenses and general government revenue by \$43,084 to upgrade detection and automated response systems, integrate advanced sensors, and support staff training on new technologies. The grant period is through August 31, 2026.

Some grant-funded purchases may have ongoing costs (e.g., software subscriptions). The Information Technology Division will evaluate these items as part of a comprehensive cyber security strategy and may prioritize them within future EUTF budgets, if they choose to continue them after grant funds expire.
