Our Mission

Vision & Values

The Joseph Project is a faith based initiative to connect it's participants with Careers. Participants go through a weeklong life skills training program and then are offered the chance to interview with companies looking to hire for full-time, directhire, career-potential jobs.

The goal of The Joseph Project is to Educate, Encourage, Empower and Elevate individuals who participate in the program. The program runs on faith in God and his ability to transform the mind of mankind.



\longrightarrow 4E's of the Joseph Project

Educate: The Joseph Project provides education for each program participant that leads directly to securing employment. Classes include: Communication Skills, Financial Management, Achieving Goals, Prioritizing Time, Conflict Resolution, Spiritual Fitness and Workplace Team etiquette.

Encourage: Volunteers of the Joseph Project encourages each candidate by taking the time to learn their struggles, helping the candidate work through those struggles with compassion and building trust with each candidate to become master of their future.

Empower: Joseph Project volunteers empower candidates to take charge of their lives and eliminate dependence on government assistance. They help with resume improvement, engage in practice interview sessions, share tips on personal appearance and body language in the interview. Candidates who need professional interview attire



can select from the Joseph Project clothing bank.

Elevate: Volunteers of the Joseph Project mentor each candidate to elevate themselves regardless of race, religion or past. The Joseph Project believes true change comes from within by renewed commitment to faith.

Our Statistics

Since 2015 we have trained over 825 women and men, with over 565 landing jobs. Most entry-level employers struggle to retain even half their new employees. With steadily improved training, the Joseph Project most recent 12-month retention rate is over 90%. Joseph Project graduates have earned wages totaling over 25 Million dollars. Combined with taxpayer dollars saved, the total economic impact of the Joseph Project to Wisconsin is over \$65 Million.
