

## 2025 Pavement Management Projects FAQs

### Pewaukee Lake Access Pavement Restoration

1. What is the scope of the Project? In 2022, Waukesha County replaced the concrete launch portion of the access site. With this project, all the asphalt pavement, including the parking areas and the roads, will be removed and replaced in four phases, from the launch out to Maple Avenue. The footprint of the new asphalt paved areas will match the existing footprint, with one exception: a new concrete slab will be added adjacent to the concrete launch to provide a reinforced surface to aid in boat removal.
2. What is the timeline of the Project? Construction is slated to begin June 2, 2025, and is expected to last into October. The first phase is the construction of the reinforced concrete slab adjacent to the launch, the second and third phases will address the parking areas, and the final phase will restore the access road into the facility. Construction will be paused during the 4<sup>th</sup> of July and Labor Day holidays.
3. Will the launch/access to the lake be closed during construction? Access will remain open except for short-term, temporary closures as necessary. Parking may be limited at times. Construction will occur mainly during the week with weekend work as necessary.
4. What other lake access sites are nearby in case of closures? Other Waukesha County Lake Access sites nearby are Nagawicka Lake Access, at the southeast corner of Lake Nagawicka at Naga-Waukee Park on Mariner Drive, and Nemahbin Lake Access, at the south end of Upper Nemahbin Lake on County Hwy DR.

### Muskego Park Pavement Restoration

1. What is the scope of the Project? Two separate areas are slated for construction with this project. The parking lot for Picnic Area #4 will be reconstructed and will be the first of the two projects started and completed. The picnic area will not be open for rentals during the construction but will be open for restroom use. The second part of the project will reconstruct the park entrance road from County Highway L (Janesville Road) into the park up to the entrance of the parking lot for Picnic Area #1 and the entrance of the parking lot for Picnic Area #5. There will always be at least one lane of traffic open during the construction.
2. What is the timeline of the Project? Construction is slated to begin May 12, 2025, and is expected to last into October.
3. Will access to Muskego Park be open during construction? Access will remain open except for short-term, temporary closures as necessary. All amenities within Muskego Park will be open and accessible throughout the project. Construction will occur mainly during the week with weekend work as necessary.
