Vehicle Modification Program

The Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) of Waukesha County has a new program offering funding for specific vehicle modifications.

This program helps individuals with electric/power wheelchairs or scooters gain greater independence by modifying their personal vehicles for easier transportation.

Take charge of your transportation!


This pilot program empowers you to regain the freedom of the open road.

How It Works

- You work directly with a licensed mobility provider to create a personalized plan for your needs.
- Choose the modification that best suits your needs: a scooter or powerchair lift and obtain an estimate from a licensed mobility provider.
- You complete an application with the ADRC, and if approved:
 - The program provides financial support for approved purchases and installations.

Eligibility

- You are a Waukesha County resident aged 18 years or older, AND
- You identify having a disability which significantly impairs your ability to drive, ride, or access a personal vehicle; or that requires use of a mobility device or transfer aide which cannot be accommodated in a personal vehicle without modifications



Important Notes

- You must obtain a valid quote from a licensed mobility provider and have an approved ADRC application before reimbursement
- Your vehicle must be owned by you or an immediate family member
- Funding is limited
