

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 171-32

MODIFY THE BRIDGES LIBRARY SYSTEM 2016 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND  
APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDING TO IMPROVE LIBRARY SERVICES  
TO YOUTH AND CITIZENS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

WHEREAS, the State Department of Public Instruction (DPI) approved the Library Services Technology Act (LSTA) grant request from the Bridges Library System on behalf of seven Wisconsin Library Systems, and

WHEREAS, the Bridges Library System received an official Notification of Grant Award in the amount of \$7,000, and

WHEREAS, the 2016 budget for the Bridges Library System does not include appropriations for this project, and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used for mini grants to libraries in 15 counties in the following library systems: Bridges Library System, Eastern Shores Library System, Kenosha County Library System, Lakeshores Library System, Mid-Wisconsin Federated Library System, Milwaukee County Federated Library System and Winnefox Library System for projects to improve library services and programs for serving youth and those with special needs in the communities they serve, and

WHEREAS, the proposed use of these grant funds has no direct impact on either the County General Tax Levy or the Special Library Tax Levy.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Bridges Library System may accept up to \$7,000 of federal Library Services and Technology (LSTA) grant funds passed through the State Department of Public Instruction (DPI).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Bridges Library System 2016 State Aids and Federal Fund Budget be modified by increasing General Government revenue by \$7,000 and Operating Expenses by \$7,000 to cover project costs associated with this grant.

This ordinance authorizes the Bridges Library System to accept and appropriate \$7,000 of Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) Library Services Technology Act (LSTA) Grant revenues on behalf of seven Wisconsin Library Systems. The funds will be distributed by the Bridges Library System to libraries in fifteen Wisconsin counties to improve library services and programs for serving youth and people with special needs.

This ordinance results in no direct impact to the County general tax levy or the Special Library tax levy.
