

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 180-69

MODIFY THE 2026 DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS BUDGET TO
ACCEPT FIREHOUSE SUBS PUBLIC SAFETY FOUNDATION GRANT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Department of Emergency Preparedness recognizes the need to maintain radio and communications equipment that is interoperable with partner agencies and compatible with emerging communications systems; and

WHEREAS, the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation administers a grant program designed to equip first responders with the resources they need to keep our communities safe, among other priorities; and

WHEREAS, the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation awarded \$38,907 of grant funding to the Waukesha County Department of Emergency Preparedness for the purpose of purchasing eight new portable emergency management cache radios and accessories; and

WHEREAS, this project will not require any local match and it is anticipated that grant funds will be sufficient to complete the purchase without the need of additional appropriations.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Department of Emergency Preparedness is authorized to accept \$38,907 of Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation grant funding for the purpose of purchasing new portable emergency management cache radios and accessories and to execute any documents necessary to accept and implement the grant.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the 2026 Waukesha County Department of Emergency Preparedness – Radio Services budget be modified to increase fixed assets and other revenue by \$38,907 to carry out the grant project.

FISCAL NOTE

MODIFY THE 2026 DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS BUDGET TO
ACCEPT FIREHOUSE SUBS PUBLIC SAFETY FOUNDATION GRANT FUNDING

This ordinance modifies the 2026 Department of Emergency Preparedness – Radio Services budget to accept an additional \$38,907 in grant funding from the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation for the purchase of radio equipment. The budget is modified to increase fixed assets by \$38,907 for this purchase. No county match is required.

This budget modification ensures the department can acquire the necessary radio equipment to transition the Emergency Management cache of portable radios to be Phase II compliant for the updated WISCOM 7/800 MHz system in 2028. The project will fund 8 of the 22 radios that Emergency Management will eventually need to replace. Other grants approved last year (Wisconsin Office of Emergency Communications Interoperable Radio Grant, Enrolled Ordinance 180-08, and TC Energy Build Strong Grant, Enrolled Ordinances 180-O-045 and 180-O-062) are already funding the replacement of 11 of these radios, and the department will continue to seek out grants to fund replacements in advance of the 2028 deadline.

1. An ACH transfer will be remitted to the organization name as stated in this memo of understanding and **must** match the EIN number submitted on the grant request and bank account information listed on the ACH Authorization. If there is a change in either information, you must submit a W-9.
2. **Purchase** the equipment on Approved Quote #3057602 from Motorola Solutions.
 - a. **NOTE: DO NOT PREPAY** for the equipment order at the time of purchase
3. **Confirm Receipt of ACH Transfer** by emailing procurementfoundation@firehousesubs.com
4. **Verify Purchase and Delivery** by providing Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation with the following:
 - a. All signed and dated packing slips
 - b. Copies of paid invoices, verifying your organization's name as the customer and matching the vendor quote(s)
 - c. A copy of the cleared check(s), verifying the payee and payment amount matches the vendor quote(s)
5. In the event that the purchased equipment costs less than the dollar amount awarded, all excess funds must be returned to Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation.
 - a. Email procurementfoundation@firehousesubs.com with notification of excess funds within 30 days of purchase
 - b. Return Excess Funds within 30 days of receipt of excess funds invoice to Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation, Attention: Foundation Finance, Deerwood North, 4600 Touchton Rd. East, Bldg. 100, Ste. 300, Jacksonville, FL 32246
6. If purchases exceed funding, **Waukesha County, on behalf of Waukesha County Emergency Management** is responsible for the additional amount.
