**CTH D (Cleveland Avenue)
Root River Tributary Structure
Waukesha County
Project I.D. 23-2772(17)**

Project Overview

The project was originally scoped as a structure rehabilitation project consisting of structural lining of existing twin barrel steel culverts. Recent findings require the scope to be changed to a structure replacement.

The structure carries CTH D traffic over a tributary of the Root River. The site is located approximately 0.1 miles west of 124th Street in the City of New Berlin. Some easements or land acquisition will be required for this project.

The structure was initially constructed in 1959. The structure consists of two 8-foot span corrugated steel structural plate culverts. The lower portion of the culverts are severely deteriorated, resulting in the need to rehabilitate the structure.

The project will be constructed closed to through traffic. Motorists should expect minor delays. The project is county funded. Construction is anticipated summer, 2028.
