







LAYOUT NAME - 01-pp







PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING CTH VV (SILVER SPRING DR) WESTBOUND BRIDGE OVER MENOMONEE RIVER – BRIDGE REHABILITATION WAUKESHA COUNTY

Meeting will be December 13th at Butler Village Hall

(WAUKESHA, WI) – The Waukesha County Department of Public Works, along with their engineering consultant Bloom Companies, Inc., will host a public involvement meeting for a project to rehabilitate the westbound bridge on CTH VV (Silver Spring Dr) over the Menomonee River. The project site is in the Village of Butler. The meeting will be held on Wednesday, December 13, 2023, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the Butler Village Hall, located at 12621 W. Hampton Avenue, Butler, WI 53007.

The project includes bridge deck replacement, concrete repairs, roadway approach paving, and guardrail replacement. Construction is expected to start in 2025.

The meeting will be an open-house format with no formal presentation. Exhibits will be on display and a project handout will be available. Anyone with interest in this project is encouraged to stop by anytime between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Representatives from Waukesha County and Bloom Companies, Inc. will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.
