

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 180-7

ACCEPT IN-KIND DONATION TO THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF SIX AEDS AND
FORTY-TWO FIRE SUPPRESSION TOOLS FROM THE WISCONSIN MASONIC
FOUNDATION

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Masonic Foundation has expressed an interest in donating six automated external defibrillators (AEDs) and forty-two fire suppression devices; and

WHEREAS, the fire suppression devices will provide the Sheriff's Department with additional tools for fire suppression otherwise outside of the department's capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the donation of the AEDs will provide additional defibrillators that the department would otherwise not have access to; and

WHEREAS, the total value of the AEDs is \$18,000 and the total value of the fire suppression devices is \$52,500; and

WHEREAS, the additional equipment will increase the department's capabilities and ability to respond in emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, as a special condition, Sheriff's Department staff must be trained on the proper use of the fire suppression devices; and

WHEREAS, the manufacturer of the fire suppression device will provide training to Sheriff's Department staff on proper use of this device; and


WHEREAS, Waukesha County Code Section 7.91(b)4 requires that in-kind donations with a replacement value of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or more as determined by the recipient department, or those subject to a special condition, must be accepted by the County Board.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department is authorized to accept the donated equipment consisting of six AEDs and forty-two fire suppression devices from the Wisconsin Masonic Foundation.
