

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 181-08

ACCEPT IN-KIND DONATION TO THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF A GUNSHOT  
SIMULATION DEVICE FOR CANINE TRAINING

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Deputy Charities Association has expressed an interest in donating a gunshot simulation device to the Sheriff's Department; and

WHEREAS, the device will be utilized for training purposes including training in the canine unit; and

WHEREAS, the total value of the device is \$17,000; and


WHEREAS, Waukesha County Code Section 7.91(b)4 requires that in-kind donations with a replacement value of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or more as determined by the recipient department, or those subject to a special condition, must be accepted by the County Board.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department is authorized to accept the donated gunshot simulation device from the Waukesha County Deputy Charities Association.



ACCEPT IN-KIND DONATION TO THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF A GUNSHOT  
SIMULATION DEVICE FOR CANINE TRAINING

This ordinance authorizes the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department to accept the donation of a gunshot simulation device for the canine unit. This device is intended to simulate the sound of gunshots to get canines used to the loud noise. The value of this donation is \$17,000. The department does not anticipate any costs associated with training using this device and anticipates that, if it was needed, the company would provide the training at no cost to the county. The department indicates that this donation is unlikely to result in any ongoing or future costs. Future replacements will be dependent upon subsequent donations or other funding.
