

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 181-33

ACCEPT MARQUETTE UNIVERSITY HIGH SCHOOL DONATION OF SOUND SYSTEM
IMPROVEMENTS AT EBLE PARK ICE ARENA AND APPROVE COOPERATIVE
AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Enrolled Ordinance 142-59 accepted the Eble property donation for park and recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, Enrolled Ordinance No. 142-178 allocated funds for the construction of the Waukesha County Eble Ice Arena Project in 1988; and

WHEREAS, Eble Park Ice Arena opened in 1988; and

WHEREAS, Marquette University High School (MUHS) has considered Eble Park Ice Arena as their home ice since it opened; and

WHEREAS, MUHS approached the Department of Parks and Land Use about donating a new sound system and related equipment for installation at Eble Park Ice Arena, as generally described in the Lewis Sound, Inc. proposal dated July 29, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the sound system improvements have a replacement value projected to be \$35,607.00; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Land Use will enter into a cooperative agreement with MUHS under which MUHS would contract directly with Lewis Sound, Inc. for the purchase, installation, and payment of the sound system improvements at no cost to the County, and the County would receive, as sole owner, the completed improvements upon satisfactory completion; and

WHEREAS, the cooperative agreement would identify the special conditions to accepting the donation, including provision of reasonable access to Eble Park Ice Arena for installation, recognition of MUHS as a donor, and coordination of a joint announcement; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-91(b) Waukesha County Code of Ordinances requires that all in-kind donations with a value of \$5,000 or more or subject to a special condition be accepted by the County Board.

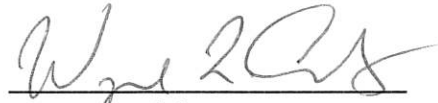
THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the donation of the sound system improvements to Eble Park Ice Arena by the Marquette University High School is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Department of Parks and Land Use is authorized to authorized to negotiate and enter into a cooperative agreement with the Marquette University High School for the purchase, installation, and donation of the sound system improvements that ensures the improvements are provided at no cost to the County and that ownership transfers to the County upon satisfactory completion, in a form to be approved by Corporation Counsel.

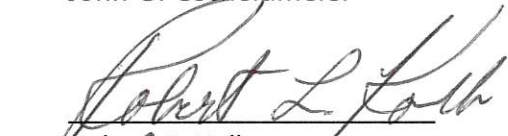

FISCAL NOTE

ACCEPT MARQUETTE UNIVERSITY HIGH SCHOOL DONATION OF SOUND SYSTEM
IMPROVEMENTS AT EBLE PARK ICE ARENA AND APPROVE COOPERATIVE
AGREEMENT

This ordinance would authorize the Department of Parks and Land Use to accept the donation of a sound system for installation at Eble Ice Arena, valued at \$35,607. The sound system would be purchased by Marquette University High School (MUHS) and would transfer to county ownership upon installation and be available for all ice arena business generally, not just by MUHS. This ordinance also authorizes the county to enter into a cooperative agreement that outlines how this partnership will be promoted and details the transfer of ownership of this asset to the county (mentioned above).

Department management expect ongoing maintenance costs for this system to be minimal, and repairs will be initially covered by a warranty period (one year for labor, one to five years for equipment, depending on the specific models).
