

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 168-11

ACCEPT DONATED MONEY SCANNER FROM THE NATIONAL
GUARD AND LAKE WINNEBAGO METRO UNIT

WHEREAS, the National Guard provided the Lake Winnebago Metro Unit with \$6,400 of their available seized funds to purchase and donate a money scanner to the Waukesha County Metro Drug Unit to allow staff in the unit to scan serial numbers from the money that is used to purchase drugs, and

WHEREAS, the money scanner would be an asset to the Metro Drug Unit by allowing staff to gather serial numbers for evidentiary purposes, and

WHEREAS, Waukesha County Code Section 7.91(b)4 requires that in-kind donations with a replacement value of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) or more as determined by the recipient department or those subject to a special condition must be accepted by the County Board, and

WHEREAS, the value of the money scanner is approximately \$6,400, and

WHEREAS, this money scanner will not be included in a replacement plan or replacement will not be levy funded.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department be allowed to accept the money scanner donated by the National Guard through the Lake Winnebago Metro Unit.

ACCEPT DONATED MONEY SCANNER FROM THE NATIONAL GUARD

This ordinance authorizes the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department to accept the donation of a money scanner which was purchased using National Guard asset forfeiture funds by the Lake Winnebago Metro Unit for the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department. The approximate value of the money scanner is \$6,400. According to the Department, the money scanner will not be added to an equipment replacement plan. The Department has also indicated that annual maintenance contract costs are \$486 which includes inspection and any necessary repairs. These cost will be absorbed within the Department's existing budget.
