**INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS AND COMMITTEE MEMBERS**

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Minutes from the March 12, 2015 meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Joan Sternweis, second by Mike O'Brien to approve minutes as written. Motion was passed.

**PRESENTATION**

LeeAnn Cooper presented on the Wisconsin Intoxicated Driver Program, providing information on multiple aspects of the program. The goals of the presentation were to provide an overview of IDP, administrative code requirements and statewide program activity. Ms. Cooper reviewed DHS 62, Wis. Admin. Code: assessment of drivers with alcohol or controlled substance problems and Trans 107, Wis. Admin. Code: Driver licensing of persons with chemical abuse or dependency problems.

**DISCUSSION OF FUTURE TOPICS AND PRESENTERS**

John Kettler asked the committee for ideas about future topics and reported that a possible topic would be the impact legalization of recreational use of marijuana has had on Colorado. John also reported that the next committee meeting will include a presentation by the Serenity Recovery Clinic as they apply for status as an IDP provider. The clinic has offices in New London and Greenfield.

**CHAIR REPORT**

John Kettler announced that Kathy Westcot and Jose Ruiz have retired from the clinical services unit at WCHHSD and that the clinic is in the process of hiring to fill the vacant positions. John informed the committee that emphasis will be on hiring candidates who have expertise in dual diagnosis.

John Kettler reported that the alcohol treatment court (ATC) and the drug treatment court (DTC) now require participants to attend support groups that are being conducted by AODA volunteers at the outpatient clinic at WCHHSD. The groups are specific each program and are held weekly.

Participants of the program are required to attend the support group at least once monthly, in addition to other program requirements. The DTC support group is held on Monday evenings at 6:30 pm and the ATC support group is held on Tuesday evenings also at 6:30 pm.

John Kettler reported that 4 people graduated from the DTC program yesterday (6/10/2015) and 26 have graduated since the program started.
