

ERIN HILLS

Forty-five minutes northwest of Milwaukee, Erin Hills offers a challenge with its natural terrain borne out of the Ice Age more than 10,000 years ago.

Before developing into Erin Hills, the land was a cattle farm, owned by the Millikin family. Some of the original structures still exist on site, including a barn from the late 19th century.



Designed by Dana Fry, Michael Hurdzan and Ron Whitten and opened in 2006, the course features fine fescue fairways and native areas that give Erin Hills a distinctive links-style look. Under new ownership since October 2009, the course has undergone renovation and maturation. Today, it can stretch over 8,000 yards.

The golf course consists of bentgrass greens and tees along with its fescue fairways, which gives it a distinctive browned-out look. This turf allows the course to play firm and fast.



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The property features a 25-acre practice facility, including an expansive short game area. Recent improvements to the course include a newly-renovated green on hole #3 as well as four new tees.



Erin Hills offers on-site accommodations for 17 in The Lodge, as well as four cottages, each with four bedrooms and four bathrooms. There is also the Clubhouse with indoor and outdoor dining facilities along with an expanded Golf Shop.

Erin Hills is rapidly gaining a national reputation as one of America's best golf experiences. In the 2015-16 Golf Digest course ratings, Erin Hills was named the 42nd best course in the country – its debut to the list. It is also ranked the 8th best public course in the United States.

Finally, Erin Hills has championship qualities that the United States Golf Association quickly recognized. The course hosted the 2008 U.S. Women's Amateur Public Links. Three years later, Erin Hills staged the U.S. Amateur and featured such rising stars as Kelly Kraft, Champion, Peter Uihlein, Russell Henley, Patrick Cantlay, Patrick Rodgers, Scott Langley and Jordan Spieth.

The course is now in preparation for the 2017 United States Open – the first time the championship will be held in Wisconsin.
