**COUNTY BOARD PASSES VRAKAS’ BUDGET;
FREEZES TAX BILL**

WAUKESHA, WI – The Waukesha County Board of Supervisors passed the County Budget today by a vote of 18-3. County Executive Dan Vrakas released the following statement regarding the budget’s passage:

“I am pleased with the County Board’s overwhelming support of the 2014 Budget. The budget freezes the County’s portion of the property tax bill on a median valued home and ensures that Waukesha County will retain its status as a low tax leader in our state. It is with great respect for the taxpayers of this County that we will continue to have the lowest tax rate among our contiguous counties, the third lowest tax rate in the entire state, and I am proud to say that we do it without imposing a county sales tax.

I would like to thank County Board Chairman Paul Decker, Finance Chair Pat Haukohl and the members of the County Board for passing a County Budget that will help maintain our coveted AAA/Aaa bond ratings, respect County taxpayers, and meet our high standards of public safety, high quality services and first-rate infrastructure.”
