**HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION PLANNED IN WAUKESHA COUNTY**  
*County Trunk Highway VV (Silver Spring Drive)*

Waukesha, WIS. – Waukesha County Department of Public Works, in coordination with Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WDOT), will begin reconstruction activities on County Trunk Highway (CTH) VV, from just west of the Fox River to Jackson Drive in the Village of Menomonee Falls. Construction will involve replacing the existing two-lane facility with a four-lane roadway along with replacement of the structures over the Fox River on CTH VV and CTH Y. Local traffic should use caution and expect delays within the construction zone.

Construction activities and road closure are scheduled to begin Monday, April 22, 2013. The road will remain closed until the bridge work is completed in mid-September. Detours for CTH VV and CTH Y will be posted during this time. Following completion of the bridge construction, the roadway will open to thru traffic on various lane configurations. All work is anticipated to be substantially completed and the new roadway fully open to traffic by mid-November.

Michels Corporation of Brownsville, Wisconsin will construct the project as the prime contractor. Patrick Engineering of Waukesha will perform construction management and inspection services for Wisconsin Department of Transportation.
