



## **Waukesha County Intoxicated Driver Intervention Program**

The Intoxicated Driver Intervention Program provides intensive supervision to repeat drunk driving defendants shortly after arrest in an effort to get them enrolled in substance abuse treatment as soon as possible during the pretrial phase, with the goal of reducing drunk driving recidivism. Compliance with program requirements and treatment may result in a reduced jail sentence.

Intoxicated Driver Intervention Program participants are monitored and allowed to live in the community while awaiting court dates as long as they comply with court-ordered bond conditions. Secure Continuous Remote Alcohol Monitoring (SCRAM) is often used as a sanction or voluntarily to continuously monitor participants' alcohol use, increase compliance, or reduce the number of required in-person supervision appointments.
