3 ENDORSE THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF FEDERAL GRANT FOR MOSQUITO
4 ASSESSMENT AND CONTROL RELATED TO THE WEST NILE VIRUS AND
5 OTHER MOSQUITO-BORNE VIRUSES THAT CAUSE HUMAN
6 ILLNESS IN THE CITY OF WAUKESHA

8 WHEREAS the West Nile Virus is an arbovirus transmitted by mosquitoes to humans, and
9

10 WHEREAS the City of Waukesha has been chosen by the Wisconsin Department of Health and
11 Family Services, Division of Public Health, to be the recipient of services to mitigate human
12 impact from mosquito-borne viruses such as West Nile Virus, based upon its population as an
13 urban area with more than 60,000 people, and

15 WHEREAS West Nile Virus causes a disease which may produce significant illness and is
16 potentially fatal in a small percentage of the population, and
17

18 WHEREAS the City of Waukesha wishes to participate with the Division of Environmental
19 Health to reduce the potential of the transmission of West Nile Virus in the City of Waukesha,
20 and

22 WHEREAS the grant offer in the amount of \$9,761 for mosquito assessment and control in the
23 City of Waukesha is for the contract dates for August 30, 2002 through June 30, 2003.

25 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES
26 ORDAIN that the Department of Parks and Land Use, Division of Environmental Health, accept
27 \$9,761 of Federal Grant funding through the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family
28 Services.

30 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Waukesha County Parks and Land Use 2003 Adopted
31 Budget be modified by increasing intergovernmental revenues by \$9,761, and increasing
32 personnel costs \$1,500, operating expenses \$7,761, and Interdepartmental charges \$500 to cover
33 costs associated with implementing mosquito assessment and control in the City of Waukesha.


