3 APPROPRIATE JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY INCENTIVE BLOCK GRANT
4 FUNDING FOR THE WAUKESHA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF

8 WHEREAS the State Office of Justice Assistance has awarded, for the fourth year, federal
9 Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant (JAIBG) to Waukesha County in the amount of
10 \$94,720 for the period June 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003, which is \$8,705 greater than the
11 2002 budget anticipated, and
12

13 WHEREAS the Waukesha County Department of Health and Human Services purchases a
14 Mediation Program, which is designed to provided victim-offender conferencing as an effective
15 form of juvenile accountability, and
16

17 WHEREAS one to one victim-offender conferencing is unfeasible for some juveniles due to their
18 own limitations, or a victim's decision not to participate, and
19

20 WHEREAS these juveniles could benefit from participation in a Youth Accountability Group
21 where volunteer victims discuss, and expose these juveniles to, the effects of victimization, and

23 WHERAS the Department anticipated receiving a total of \$77,424 of JAIBG funding for the
24 2002 calendar year of which \$52,770 relates to the State's 2001-02 grant award and \$24,654
25 relates to the State's 2002-03 grant award, and

27 WHEREAS the Department estimates that expanded program would use \$8,705 from the
28 increased grant award between June 1, 2002 and December 31, 2002, for purposes of developing
29 and providing Youth Accountability Groups as part of the Mediation Program, and


31 WHEREAS the remaining 2002-03 JAIBG grant funds of \$61,361 will be included in the 2003
32 budget.


34 The COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS
35 that the 2002 Adolescent and Family Services Juvenile Services Organization budget be
36 modified by increasing General Government revenues by \$8,705 and by increasing Operating
37 Expenses by the same amount to cover the cost of contracting for expanded Mediation
38 programming.


