7 WHEREAS, Enrolled Ordinance 141-41 authorized the Sheriff's Department to participate in a
8 program to transfer federally seized assets to local enforcement agencies, and

10 WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department has such assets that had not been allocated during the
11 2001 and 2002 budget processes, and

13 WHEREAS, as of July 14, 2002 the Sheriff's Department has received additional seized assets in
14 both 2001 and 2002 that are unallocated, and

16 WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department acts as trustee for a portion of these funds on behalf of
17 agencies participating in the Waukesha County Metro Drug Unit.

19 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES
20 ORDAIN that \$52,603 in unallocated federally seized assets be appropriated from the reserved
21 general fund balance to increase the Sheriff's Department 2002 expenditure budget and revenue
22 budget in the appropriate accounts for distribution of seized funds to the entitled participating
23 agencies.
