3 APPROPRIATE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE WAIVER FUNDING FOR  
4 THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

7 WHEREAS the Waukesha Department of Health and Human Services has been receiving  
8 Medical Assistance Waiver funding since 1984, and  
9

10 WHEREAS the State of Wisconsin makes available Medical Assistance Waiver funds to relocate  
11 or divert eligible people from state centers for the developmentally disabled, intermediate care  
12 facilities specializing in mental retardation services and skilled nursing facilities, and  
13

14 WHEREAS the 2001-2003 biennial state budget provided an increase in Medical Assistance  
15 Waiver funds to counties to reduce waiting lists of frail elderly and persons with physical and  
16 developmental disabilities in need of community based care and services, and  
17

18 WHEREAS the Waukesha County Department of Health and Human Services 2000-2003  
19 Strategic Plan calls for a planned reduction in the number of people waiting for long term  
20 supports, and  
21

22 WHEREAS if any of the additional funds go unused in 2002 for new persons, the county's  
23 allocation may be reduced permanently and the amount of unearned funds will be reallocated to  
24 other counties, and

26 WHEREAS the 2002 Department of Health and Human Services budget did not include the  
27 Medical Assistance Waiver funding at the finalized amounts.

29 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES  
30 ORDAIN that the 2002 Long Term Care Fund budget of the Department of Health and Human  
31 Services be modified by increasing General Government revenues by \$ 1,386,826 and by  
32 increasing Operating Expenses by the same amount to cover the costs of purchasing community  
33 based care and services through the use of State of Wisconsin Medical Assistance Waiver  
34 funding.
