9 WHEREAS bioterrorism poses a new domestic threat to U.S. homeland security as evidenced by
10 the deaths last year due to the biological weaponizing of anthrax, and

11
12 WHEREAS the United States Government has declared bioterrorism as a major modern day
13 public health threat, and

14
15 WHEREAS the US Center for Disease Control (CDC) has declared public health departments
16 across America as first responders to contain and control a bioterrorism incident, and

17
18 WHEREAS US House Bill 3153 "State Bioterrorism Preparedness Act" provides funding to
19 states to prepare state and local public health agencies to respond to bioterrorism events, and

21 WHEREAS the State of Wisconsin has received a \$19,000,000 allocation for public health
22 department bioterrorism preparedness, and

24 WHEREAS the dollar amount of the allocation and the allowable use of the funds were not
25 determined until the after the 2002 budget was adopted, and

27 WHEREAS the Waukesha Department of Health and Human Services has now received an
28 allocation of \$55,729 for bioterrorism local and regional consortium planning and training
29 effective January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002.

31 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES
32 ORDAIN that the Department of Health and Human Services is authorized to accept \$55,729 of
33 Centers for Disease Control Bioterrorism funding as awarded by the State of Wisconsin,
34 Department of Health and Family Services, Division of Public Health.

36 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the 2002 Department of Health and Human Services, Public
37 Health Division budget be modified by increasing General Government revenues by \$55,729 and
38 increasing the Operating Expenses by \$51,729 and Interdepartmental Charges by \$4,000 for
39 expenditures and purchase of services as delineated in the State of Wisconsin CDC Bioterrorism
40 Preparedness Amendment to Year 2002 Consolidated Contract with Waukesha County.
