3 ENDORSE THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF FEDERAL GRANT FOR MOSQUITO
4 ASSESSMENT AND CONTROL RELATED TO THE WEST NILE AND OTHER
5 MOSQUITO-BORNE VIRUSES THAT CAUSE HUMAN ILLNESS

7 WHEREAS, the West Nile Virus is an arbovirus transmitted by mosquitoes to humans, and
8

9 WHEREAS, the City of Waukesha, the City of Brookfield, City of New Berlin and Village
10 of Menomonee Falls have been chosen by the state Department of Health and Family Services,
11 Division of Public Health, to be the recipient of services to mitigate human impact from
12 mosquito-borne viruses such as West Nile Virus, based upon its population as an urban area with
13 more than 1,000 people per square mile, and

15 WHEREAS, West Nile Virus causes a disease which may produce significant illness and is
16 potentially fatal in a small percentage of the population, and
17

18 WHEREAS, the City of Waukesha, City of Brookfield, City of New Berlin and Village of
19 Menomonee Falls wish to participate in the grant offer with the Division of Environmental
20 Health to reduce the potential of the transmission of West Nile Virus in their communities, and

21 WHEREAS, the grant offer in the amount of \$12,962 for mosquito assessment and control in
22 these communities is for the contract dates July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004.

24 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES
25 ORDAIN that the Department of Parks and Land Use, Division of Environmental Health, accept
26 the \$12,962 of Federal Grant funding through the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family
27 Services.


29 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Waukesha County Parks and Land Use 2004

31 increasing operating expenses by \$12,962.



FISCAL NOTE

ENDORSE THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF FEDERAL GRANT FOR
MOSQUITO ASSESSMENT AND CONTROL RELATED TO THE WEST NILE VIRUS
AND OTHER MOSQUITO-BORNE VIRUSES THAT CAUSE HUMAN ILLNESS

Approval of this ordinance modifies the 2004 Waukesha County Parks and Land Use budget by authorizing the acceptance of \$12,962 of Federal grant funds passed through the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) to provide mosquito assessment and control in the City of Waukesha, City of Brookfield, City of New Berlin and Village of Menomonee Falls.

Parks and Land Use indicate the entire \$12,962 in grant funds will be divided equally in the amount of \$3,204.50 per municipality to fund mosquito assessment and control expenses.

The department indicates administrative costs will be absorbed within existing 2004 budgeted appropriations. No County indirect costs are covered by these grant funds. The ordinance results in no additional direct tax levy impact.
