9 WHEREAS, the 2004 Parks & Land Use budget objectives provide for beach water quality  
10 testing, and

12 WHEREAS, *Cylindrospermopsis* is a blue-green algae, that was first identified to be present in  
13 Pewaukee Lake during the Summer of 2003, and  
14

15 WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Department of Parks & Land Use, Division of  
16 Environmental Health has been chosen by the state Department of Health and Family Services,  
17 Division of Public Health, to be the recipient of a grant to survey Waukesha County lakes for the  
18 presence of *Cylindrospermopsis*, and

20 WHEREAS, *Cylindrospermopsis*, when present in high levels, may cause illness and increases  
21 health risk to recreational users, and  
22

23 WHEREAS, under the State grant the County will receive \$3,500 to survey Waukesha County  
24 lakes for the presence of *Cylindrospermopsis* by September 29, 2004.


26 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES  
27 ORDAIN that the Department of Parks and Land Use, Division of Environmental Health, accept  
28 the \$3,500 of a grant from the state Department of Health and Family Services, Division of  
29 Public Health, to survey Waukesha County lakes for the presence of *Cylindrospermopsis*.


31 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Waukesha County Parks and Land Use 2004 Adopted  
32 Budget be modified by increasing intergovernmental revenues by \$3,500 and increasing

34 the costs to survey Waukesha County lakes for the presence of *Cylindrospermopsis*.


ENDORSE THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND FAMILY SERVICES, BUREAU OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH, CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT GRANT TO MONITOR FOR THE PRESENCE OF CYLINDROSPERMOPSIS IN WAUKESHA COUNTY LAKES

Approval of this ordinance modifies the 2004 Waukesha County Parks and Land Use budget by authorizing the acceptance of \$3,500 of State grant revenues passed through the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services Public Health Division (DHFS) to provide monitoring of Waukesha County Lakes for the presence of Cylindrospermopsis.

Parks and Land Use staff indicate that \$2,500 will be used for temporary extra help (approximately 230 hours) to survey and monitor the ~~27~~ public beaches in Waukesha County multiple times during the summer swimming season and \$1,000 for estimated operating expenses to purchase contracted water sample testing services.

The department staff also indicate administrative costs related to this grant may be absorbed within existing 2004 budgeted appropriations. No County indirect costs are covered by these grant funds. This ordinance results in no additional direct tax levy impact.
