ORDER TO CONVEY TITLE
TO HIGHWAY RIGHT OF WAY TO THE STATE OF WISCONSIN

WHEREAS pursuant to an Order of the Division of Highways and Transportation Facilities under Section 84.09, Wisconsin Statutes, the County Highway Committee of Waukesha County acquired certain lands and interests to the same in the name of Waukesha County, Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS the title of said lands or interests in said lands is transferable to the State of Wisconsin upon Order of the Division of Highway and Transportation Facilities to the County Clerk and the County Highway Committee, and

WHEREAS the Division of Highway and Transportation Facilities issued an order for transfer of title to the properties described below on October 7, 2003.

FISCAL NOTE

CONVEY TITLE TO HIGHWAY RIGHT OF WAY TO THE STATE OF WISCONSIN

Section 84.09(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes authorizes the State Department of Transportation to order counties to acquire land or interests in land, with the title to the property conveyed to the counties. The same section also authorizes the State Department of Transportation to order counties to convey title of property so acquired to the State at no charge.

The property identified in this ordinance was acquired with State funds in 1955 pursuant to a State order, and an order has been received to convey title to the property from the County to the State.


There is no additional direct tax levy impact as a result of this ordinance.




