

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 159-58

AUTHORIZE THE WAUKESHA COUNTY UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN EXTENSION  
TO ACCEPT THE GREATER MILWAUKEE FOUNDATION GRANT AND TO  
AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE APPROPRIATIONS TO DELIVER  
THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM “GOING SOLO: CREATING A FAMILY  
BUSINESS FOR HISPANIC ENTREPRENEURS IN WAUKESHA”

WHEREAS the Greater Milwaukee Foundation provides funding for the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension to teach Hispanic families how to identify and develop business opportunities and to build entrepreneurial skills to retain long-term economic stability and growth, and

WHEREAS the Greater Milwaukee Foundation anticipates that the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension will expand their outreach entrepreneurial educational program which focuses on developing business capacity in both youth and their parents, and

WHEREAS the Greater Milwaukee Foundation encourages the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension to partner with Waukesha County Technical College and the Wisconsin Business Development Finance Corporation to provide business resources and guest speakers, and

WHEREAS the Greater Milwaukee Foundation has awarded the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension office \$30,000 for a program entitled Going Solo: Creating a Family Business Network for Hispanic Entrepreneurs in Waukesha, and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension 2004 adopted budget did not include this \$30,000 grant funding award for this purpose and, therefore, it needs to be appropriated in the University of Wisconsin Extension 2004 budget, and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension estimates the total cost of this educational program to be \$43,400 of which the County’s in-kind portion is \$4,900 and the State University of Wisconsin Extension’s in-kind portion is \$8,500, and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension will provide participants with educational information to weigh the decision of starting a business, and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension will continue to create opportunities for business exploration, business planning, and business start-ups.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES  
ORDAIN that the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension be authorized to accept the grant funding of \$30,000 from The Greater Milwaukee Foundation to increase entrepreneurial education to the Hispanic community in Waukesha.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension 2004 program budget be modified to increase General Governmental Revenues by \$30,000, and increase Personnel Cost appropriations for temporary extra help by \$1,291, Operating Expense appropriations by \$26,709, and Interdepartmental Expense appropriations by \$2,000 for program costs associated with fulfilling the purpose of the grant.


