

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 159-80

AMEND THE WAUKESHA COUNTY CODE TO INCLUDE PROVISIONS
PERTAINING TO THE DEPARTMENT EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Whereas Enrolled Resolution 159-R-007 creating the Department of Emergency Preparedness was approved by the County Board on August 10, 2004 and signed by the County Executive, and

Whereas Enrolled Ordinance 159-O-059 creating the position of Director of Emergency Preparedness was approved by the County Board on October 26, 2004 and signed by the County Executive, and

Whereas Proposed Ordinance 159-O-068 adopting the 2005 budget was approved by the County Board on November 9, 2004 and funds the position of Director of Emergency Preparedness effective July 1, 2005.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA
ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The County Code of Ordinances, judiciary and law enforcement committee, shall be amended by repeal and recreation of section 4-170 (c) 1. to read as follows:

(c) The duties of the judiciary and law enforcement committee shall be as follows:

1. To act as the committee of budget and policy oversight for the circuit courts, the department of emergency preparedness, the juvenile courts, the register in probate, the office of clerk of courts, the office of district attorney, the office of medical examiner, the office of sheriff, the highway safety commission, and the local emergency planning committee.

SECTION 2. The County Code of Ordinances, appointment of department heads and certain other county officers, shall be amended to add the director of emergency preparedness by repeal and recreation of the listing in Section 5-2 (1.) to read as follows:

1. Department heads and certain other county officers:

- Corporation counsel
- County surveyor
- Director of administration
- Director of emergency preparedness
- Director of senior services
- Director of health and human services
- Director of parks and land use
- Director of public works
- Director of veterans' services
- Emergency management coordinator
- Medical examiner


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective upon approval and publication.




SECTION 5. Any code section or part of a section in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed and declared null and void and of no effect.




