

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 160-48

AMEND 2005 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET -
EXPENDITURE OF SEIZED FUNDS - SEPTEMBER 2005

WHEREAS, enrolled ordinance 141-41 authorizes the Sheriff's Department "... to participate in the program to transfer federally seized property to local enforcement agencies", and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department has such assets that had not been allocated during the 2005 budget process, and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Supreme Court has ordered state law enforcement agencies to make audio recordings of all juvenile interviews/interrogations, and

WHEREAS, the Court made this ruling immediate on release of the ruling, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department needs additional equipment to comply with this ruling.


THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that \$15,464 of seized assets forfeiture funding received in 2004 be appropriated from reserved general fund balance, and increase Operating Expense appropriation by \$15,464 for the purpose of complying with the Wisconsin State Supreme court ruling on juvenile interviews / interrogations.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that \$11,536 of seized asset forfeiture funding received in 2005 be appropriated by increasing Other Revenue, and increase Operating Expenses \$11,536 for the balance of the costs.
