

ENROLLED RESOLUTION 160-20

EXPRESSION OF INTENT TO CONTINUE SELF-INSURANCE
FOR WORKER'S COMPENSATION

WHEREAS Waukesha County is a qualified political subdivision of the State of Wisconsin; and,

WHEREAS the Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act (Act) provides that employers covered by the Act either insure their liability with worker's compensation insurance carriers authorized to do business in Wisconsin, or to be exempted (self-insured) from insuring liability with a carrier and thereby assuming the responsibility for its own worker's compensation risk and payment; and,

WHEREAS the State and its political subdivisions may self-insure worker's compensation without a special order from the Department of Workforce Development (Department) if they agree to report faithfully all compensable injuries and agree to comply with the Act and rules of the Department; and,


WHEREAS the Finance Committee at its April 5, 2006 meeting approved the continuation of the self-insured worker's compensation program, in compliance with Wisconsin Administrative Code DWD 80.60(3).


