APPROPRIATE STATE OF WISCONSIN DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH 2006
CONSOLIDATED CONTRACT AMENDMENT FOR PANDEMIC INFLUENZA GRANT
FUNDING TO THE WAUKESHA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN
SERVICES, DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH

WHEREAS, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has recognized that the threat of a human Influenza pandemic has greatly increased over the past several years with the emergence of the highly virulent Avian Influenza virus, notably H5N1 virus, and

WHEREAS, historically the globe has experience an Influenza pandemic every thirty years with millions of persons contracting Influenza with the result of permanent disability or death, and

WHEREAS, an Influenza pandemic is over due as the last Influenza pandemic, was the 1968 Hong Kong Flu which caused 34,000 deaths in the U.S., and

WHEREAS, the CDC has made available Public Health Preparedness funding to the State of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Health and Family Services has awarded the Pandemic Influenza Grant in the amount of \$37,326 to Waukesha County in recognition of the following efforts: a Pandemic Influenza assessment of local readiness response, drafting a local Pandemic Influenza Response Plan, exercising the full-scale Pandemic Influenza Response Plan, and providing a Pandemic Influenza community education program for community first response partners, and

WHEREAS, State staff have reviewed and verified that the objectives of the grant had been met by August 30, 2006, and





WHEREAS, the State Division of Public Health Consolidated Contract is performance based, paying upon achievement of the objectives, and provides that any unspent funds must be expended in the current contract year or the contract year immediately following and their use must fall within the program boundaries established under the contract.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health be authorized to accept the State of Wisconsin Division of Public Health CDC Pandemic Influenza Grant in the amount of \$37,326.




BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the 2006 Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Division budget be modified by increasing general government revenues by \$37,326 and increasing interdepartmental charge appropriations \$4,480 for department indirect costs and increasing operating expense appropriations by \$32,846 for expenditures related to: instructional materials, supplies and equipment for the ongoing training and outfitting of public health first responders; and equipment for the proper storage of vaccines and supplies.
