APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO THE
WAUKESHA COUNTY DEVELOPMENT PLAN
(1A – TOM HALQUIST, SECTION 34, TOWN OF LISBON)

WHEREAS on November 26, 1996, the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors in Resolution No. 151-13 approved a Development Plan for Waukesha County to take effect January 1, 1997, and

WHEREAS on May 27, 1997, the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No.152-R-002 entitled, “Technical Refinements and Implementation of a Development Plan for Waukesha County” which, among other matters, provided for annual update and amendment procedures, and

WHEREAS on February 7, 2008, the Waukesha County Park and Planning Commission and the Waukesha County Land Use, Parks and Environment Committee held a joint Public Hearing to receive testimony on proposed changes to the Waukesha County Development Plan, and

WHEREAS the staff has identified in a “Staff Report and Recommendation” dated February 21, 2008, a summary of the public hearing, comments and Staff Recommendations for the various proposed changes to specific properties in the Waukesha County Development Plan, and

WHEREAS said “Staff Report and Recommendation” has been reviewed by the Waukesha County Park and Planning Commission on February 21, 2008, and a recommendation thereon reported to the Land Use, Parks and Environment Committee and the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors as required by Resolution No. 152-R-002 as set forth in the attached “Chart of Actions”.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE WAUKESHA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that the following amendment is hereby approved to the Year 2010 and the Buildout Map of the Waukesha County Development Plan.


1. In the Town of Lisbon, the following request is being made:
 - A. **Tom Halquist**, N51 W23563 Lisbon Road, Sussex, WI 53089, requests approximately 24 acres, south of C.T.H. “K” and west of the existing quarry operation, (Tax Key No.’s LSBT 0280.997, LSBT 0280.998, LSBT 0280.999, LSBT 0280.999.001 and the northerly part of LSBT 0280.992) be amended from the Low Density Residential category to the Extractive category, to accommodate the long-term expansion of the existing quarry located to the east of these parcels and south of C.T.H. “K”.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a more detailed description and map of the aforementioned property is on file in the office of the Waukesha County Department of Parks and Land Use.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Waukesha County Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Town Clerk of Lisbon.




