

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 163-103

HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY2007 PROGRAM
FUNDING AWARD AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
2009 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND
EXPENDITURES FOR RADIO REPROGRAMMING

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, along with the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism, and

WHEREAS, federal fiscal year 2007 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funding is available to the Urban Area agencies, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI included a funding request to reprogram portable and mobile radios on the countywide 800 MHz trunked radio system to incorporate additional talk groups and mutual aid radio frequencies to ensure inter-agency communication interoperability, and

WHEREAS, Homeland Security-UASI will provide funding to pay for Waukesha County Radio Services to reprogram 410 radios with mutual aid radio frequencies, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance has approved the investment justifications, requested Waukesha County to submit grant application documents for this project, and awarded funding.




