

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 163-37

AMEND WAUKESHA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO
ADD DISORDERLY CONDUCT WITH A MOTOR VEHICLE

WHEREAS the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department has identified unsafe uses of motor vehicles not specifically covered in the Waukesha County Code of Ordinances, and

WHEREAS other counties in the state have specific county code violations for these types of offenses and have found them useful.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA
ORDAINS:

Section 1. The following language shall be added to Chapter 13, Article II, Division 2 of the Waukesha County Code of Ordinances:

DISORDERLY CONDUCT WITH A MOTOR VEHICLE

(1) Definitions. The following terms are defined for the purpose of this ordinance:

(a) Motor Vehicle, Vehicle, and Highway shall be defined as the same terms are defined in §340.01, Wis. Stats.

(b) Disorderly Conduct With A Motor Vehicle. Means the deliberate operation of a motor vehicle in a manner that is unnecessarily and unreasonably violent, abusive, loud, maneuvered, or accelerated in such a manner so as to disturb, annoy or endanger any person or property in any public or private area in Waukesha County. It includes, but is not limited to the unnecessary and unreasonable spinning of wheels, squealing of tires, accelerating the engine or vehicle or both, raising one or more wheels off the surface, use of the horn, loud playing of radios or audio entertainment, emission of smoke, gases, or other foul odors that are disagreeable, leaving the highway to travel across property to avoid an intersection, official traffic control sign, signal or other device, and deliberately causing the engine to backfire. For the purpose of this definition, the motor vehicle is not required to be moving at the time of commission of the disorderly conduct.

(2) No person shall operate a Motor Vehicle in Waukesha County in such a manner that constitutes Disorderly Conduct with a Motor Vehicle.

SECTION 2. The forfeiture section at Chapter 13-151 shall apply to this offense.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective upon approval and publication.

SECTION 4. The provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the County of Waukesha, Wisconsin, as an addition or amendment thereto and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the numbering system contained therein.

SECTION 5. Any code section or part of a section in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed and declared null and void and of no effect.


