

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 164-107

PARKING REGULATION – CTH NN

WHEREAS the parking, standing and stopping of vehicles along streets and highways can have a detrimental effect upon capacity and safety, and

WHEREAS Wisconsin Statutes provide that local authorities may regulate the parking, standing and stopping of vehicles along such streets and highways.


THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that the following parking regulation shall be in effect upon the placement of proper signs:

The South side of CTH NN within a 25 foot long zone, within the current parking lane and adjacent to the entrance to the Village of Eagle Police Department to be used as a dedicated parking stall for police department vehicles only and will be signed appropriately.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this declaration rescinds all other previous restrictions for the above described roadway.






