APPROPRIATE STATE OF WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES,  
DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RESPONSE  
U.S. CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION GRANT FUNDING  
FOR 2009 BY INCREASING THE WAUKESHA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH  
AND HUMAN SERVICES – PUBLIC HEALTH DIVISION BUDGET

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2009 the World Health Organization declared Influenza A (H1N1) a new novel virus world wide pandemic, the first in the last 40 years, and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Secretary of State has declared H1N1 a national public health emergency, and

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has made available Public Health Emergency Response Grant Funding to provide for accelerated H1N1 pandemic influenza planning and response for the local control of this disease, and

WHEREAS, the CDC made available Public Health Emergency Response Grant funding to the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services, Division of Public Health, and


WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services, Division of Public Health has awarded Public Health Emergency Response Grant funding for Waukesha County, in the amount of \$96,569, for the purpose of H1N1 pandemic influenza pandemic planning and control for the period of one year beginning August 1, 2009.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health is authorized to accept the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services, Division of Public Health CDC Public Health Emergency Response Grant Funding in the amount of \$96,569.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Division 2009 budget be modified by increasing general government revenues by \$96,569, increasing personnel cost appropriations by \$31,500 for on call help and a temporary Limited Term employee, increasing operating expense appropriations by \$51,980, and increasing additional interdepartmental charge appropriations by \$13,089 for costs associated with Influenza A (H1N1) planning and control measures through community education, case investigation, and providing mass vaccine distribution clinics.


