ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY – EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2010 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security determined that emergency responder training remains a critical factor in local capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other all hazard events, and

WHEREAS, federal Homeland Security grant funding is available to local agencies in the State of Wisconsin through Wisconsin Emergency Management via the County Office of Emergency Management, and

WHEREAS, the Menomonee Falls Fire and Police Departments requested local delivery of Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and Incident Command and EOC Interface training, and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Emergency Management allocated funding for this training in Waukesha County, and requires Waukesha County to act as the fiscal agent to apply for and administer the grant funding on behalf of those local units of government.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Emergency Preparedness Department-Emergency Management Office is authorized to accept \$2,731 of Federal Homeland Security grant funding.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Emergency Preparedness 2010 budget be modified by increasing Intergovernmental Grant revenues by \$2,731, and increasing Operating expense appropriations by \$2,731.

ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY – EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING
FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2010 BUDGET
TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR
EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING

This ordinance authorizes the Emergency Management Office to accept Department of Homeland Security federal funding to be disbursed by the Wisconsin Emergency Management Division in the amount of \$2,731.

The purpose of this grant is to provide Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and Incident Command and EOC Interface training to the Menomonee Falls Fire and Police Departments. According to department staff, the funding is used to compensate course instructors and purchase materials for 25 participants for the two day course scheduled for January, 2010. The grant will cover the cost of the instructor fees of \$1,440, instructor travel costs of \$500 and participant manuals and materials of \$791.

This grant funded training is expected to result in no addition tax levy impact in 2010.
