ACCEPTANCE OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT DONATION FROM  
THE INNOCENT JUSTICE ASSISTANCE FOUNDATION

WHEREAS, in 2009 the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department applied to the Innocent Justice Assistance Foundation to purchase computer equipment to allow for additional computer file storage capacity for the computer forensics unit, and

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department was notified that the Innocent Justice Assistance Foundation would be willing to directly purchase the computer equipment and donate it to the Sheriff's Department, and

WHEREAS, Waukesha County Code Section 7-91(b)4 requires that in-kind donations with a replacement value of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) or more as determined by the recipient department or those subject to a special condition must be accepted by the County Board, and

WHEREAS, the estimated value for the computer equipment donation is \$12,000, and

WHEREAS, future replacement of the equipment will be with non-levy funding.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department be allowed to accept computer equipment donated by the Innocent Justice Assistance Foundation.

ACCEPTANCE OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT DONATION FROM THE

This ordinance authorizes the Sheriff's Department to accept a donation of computer storage equipment valued at \$12,000. It will be utilized by the Computer Forensics Unit to save case related images of evidentiary value until it is no longer needed in the court process. The equipment will be maintained by the Computer Forensics Unit and according to the Department is not expected to be replaced with county funding in the future.
