ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY2008
PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2011
BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR
CERT REFRESHER AND TRAIN-THE-TRAINER TRAINING

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, along with the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other all hazard events, and

WHEREAS, federal fiscal year 2008 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funding is available to the Urban Area agencies, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI included a funding request for Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Instructor Refresher Training and Train-the-Trainer Training, and

WHEREAS, UASI will provide the funding in this grant to pay for refresher training for current CERT instructors and train-the-trainer courses to develop new CERT instructors to strengthen the local pool of quality instructors and the CERT program, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance allocated funding and authorized Waukesha County to submit a grant application for this project.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Emergency Preparedness Department-Emergency Management Office be authorized to accept \$7,040 of Federal Homeland Security grant funding to pay for refresher training for current CERT instructors and train-the-trainer courses to develop new CERT instructors to strengthen the local pool of quality instructors and the CERT program.



ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY2008

BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR
CERT REFRESHER AND TRAIN-THE-TRAINER TRAINING

This ordinance requests the 2011 Emergency Preparedness-Disaster Management program budget be modified to include \$7,040 of federal Homeland Security grant award funds to support the County's participation in the Milwaukee Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI). The purpose of the Initiative is to enhance area capabilities to prevent, respond to, recover from and mitigate against all-hazard emergency and disaster situations, including both natural and man-made disasters or emergencies.

According to the Emergency Management Department, \$7,040 of the grant funds are to provide for instructor and volunteer training refresher training to ensure that current volunteers are prepared to respond during disasters. This includes instructor fees and class materials and instructors lodging, meals and mileage.

This grant results in no additional direct tax levy impact in 2011.
