

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 166-61

ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI)
FFY2008 PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
2011 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES
FOR PURCHASE OF CREDENTIALING SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT,
AND COMMUNITY AND CITIZEN PREPAREDNESS MATERIALS

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, along with the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and all other hazard events; and

WHEREAS, federal fiscal year 2008 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative(UASI) grant funding is available to the Urban Area agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI FFY2008 funding cycle resulted in a turn-back of unspent funds from various projects in the Milwaukee Urban Area, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Menomonee Falls, the Milwaukee Office of Homeland Security, and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance, agreed to fund a pilot business recovery project using a portion of the unspent turn back funds, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI opted to provide additional funding to Waukesha County Emergency Management for personnel accountability credentialing and community preparedness supplies, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance approved the investment justifications, allocated funding, authorized Waukesha County to submit a grant modification, and will issue a supplemental grant award to Waukesha County to fund these projects.




FISCAL NOTE

AND CITIZEN PREPAREDNESS MATERIALS

This ordinance requests the 2011 Emergency Preparedness-Disaster Management program budget be modified to include \$6,500 of federal Homeland Security grant award funds to support the County's participation in the Milwaukee Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI). The purpose of the Initiative is to enhance area capabilities to prevent, respond to, recover from and mitigate against all-hazard emergency and disaster situations, including both natural and man-made disasters or emergencies..

According to the Emergency Management Division, the grant funds will be used to pay for contracted services and supplies related to a personnel credentialing/identification access pilot business recovery project in the Village of Menomonee Falls.

This grant results in no additional direct tax levy impact in 2011.
