ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FFY2010
PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2012
BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR
UPGRADE OF CAMERA TRAILER MODEM AND ANTENNA SYSTEMS,
AND SOFTWARE UPGRADE FOR CREDENTIALING SYSTEM

WHEREAS the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, along with the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other all hazard events; and

WHEREAS federal fiscal year 2010 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funding is available to the Urban Area agencies; and

WHEREAS the Milwaukee UASI included a funding request for maintenance and administration of ongoing UASI initiatives; and

WHEREAS UASI will provide the funding in this grant to upgrade connectivity hardware for an existing remote camera trailer, and to upgrade software for an existing credentialing system; and


WHEREAS the United States Department of Homeland Security and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance allocated funding, authorized Waukesha County to submit a grant application, and issued a grant award to Waukesha County for this project.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Emergency Preparedness Department-Emergency Management is authorized to accept \$5,000 of Federal Homeland Security grant funding for upgrade of camera trailer modem and antenna systems, and software upgrade for credentialing system.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Emergency Preparedness 2012 budget be modified by increasing Intergovernmental grant revenues by \$5,000, and increasing Operating Expense appropriations by \$5,000.



ACCEPT FISCAL NOTE

HOMELAND SECURITY-FY2010 PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE
EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2012 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT
REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR UPGRADE OF CAMERA TRAILER MODEM
AND ANTENNA SYSTEMS, AND SOFTWARE UPGRADE FOR CREDENTIALING
SYSTEM

This ordinance requests the 2012 Emergency Preparedness-Disaster Management program budget be modified to include \$5,000 of federal Homeland Security grant award funds to support the County's participation in the Milwaukee Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI). The purpose of the Initiative is to enhance area capabilities to respond to, recover from and mitigate against all-hazard emergency and disaster situations, including both natural and man-made disasters or emergencies.

The funding will be used to upgrade connectivity hardware for an existing remote camera trailer, and to upgrade software for an existing credentialing system.

This grant results in no additional direct tax levy impact in 2012.
