ACCEPT STATE OF WISCONSIN – EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING FUNDS AND
MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2013 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE
GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security allocated grant funding for emergency responder training in the State of Wisconsin to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other all hazard events, and

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin provides grant funding from this allocation to counties in the State of Wisconsin to provide emergency responder training programs, and

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Public Health Division requested training assistance to accomplish their responsibilities to develop mass fatality plans for catastrophic public health related events in coordination with other emergency response agencies and the Medical Examiner, and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Emergency Management approved funding for Waukesha County to provide the Federal Emergency Management Agency training program for Mass Fatality Incident Response.


THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY DOES ORDAIN that the Waukesha County Emergency Preparedness Department-Emergency Management Office be authorized to accept \$1,991 of Wisconsin Emergency Management Training Grant funding.




FISCAL NOTE

ACCEPT STATE OF WISCONSIN-EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING FUNDS
AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2013 BUDGET TO
APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR EMERGENCY
RESPONDER TRAINING

This ordinance authorizes the Emergency Preparedness-Disaster Management program to accept and modify the 2013 budget to include \$1,991 from a federal Homeland Security grant award passed through the State Wisconsin Emergency Management Division, State Department of Military Affairs. This ordinance will result in budget increases to Inter-government revenues and operating expense appropriations by the \$1,991

According to Department management, this funding will provide new training and guidance to local public health agencies in the southeast region of the State to develop comprehensive mass fatality response plans. Management indicates that the funding is planned to be used for the estimated cost of instructor fees at \$1,241 and training materials at an estimated cost of \$750.

The Wisconsin Emergency Management grant period ends by December 31, 2013.
