

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 168-49

ACCEPT DONATED VEHICLE BODY FROM
THE AMERICAN BODY COMPANY INC

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Board approved Enrolled Ordinance 167-84 in February 2013 to appropriate \$90,000 in seized fund money for the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department to purchase a dive team vehicle, and

WHEREAS, after working with the Purchasing Division to purchase a new dive team truck, the Department was unable to purchase the truck within the \$90,000 budget due to recent changes in emission requirements for vehicles, and

WHEREAS, while contacting vendors to determine who could bid on the dive team truck, the American Body Company Inc. indicated that if the Sheriff's Department was not successful in obtaining a new truck for the dive team, they would be interested in donating a used truck body which could be modified to meet the dive team's requirements, and

WHEREAS, Waukesha County Vehicle Replacement Plan has a chassis with approximately 39,000 miles on it and approximately 6,000 hours of engine use that can be purchased by the Sheriff's Department and modified to fit the donated vehicle body, and

WHEREAS, the anticipated modifications to the chassis and the vehicle body can be accommodated within the seized funds budget that was previously approved by the County Board in Enrolled Ordinance 167-84, and

WHEREAS, the US Department of Justice confirmed that the purchase of a used chassis and vehicle modifications were permitted uses under seized fund guidelines, and

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Code Section 7.91(b)4 requires that in-kind donations with a replacement value of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) or more as determined by the recipient department or those subject to a special condition must be accepted by the County Board, and

WHEREAS, the residual value of the donated body is approximately \$3,000, and

WHEREAS, this vehicle will not be included in a replacement plan or replacement will not be levy funded.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department be allowed to accept the vehicle body donated by the American Body Company Inc.

FISCAL NOTE

**ACCEPT DONATED VEHICLE BODY FROM
THE AMERICAN BODY COMPANY INC**

This ordinance authorizes the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department to accept the donation of a used truck body valued at approximately \$3,000 from the American Body Company. The Department plans to modify and fit the truck body on a chassis purchased from the County Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund to build a vehicle suitable for use by the Sheriff's Department Dive Team to replace one approaching the end of its useful life.

Enrolled Ordinance 167-84 had previously appropriated \$90,000 of seized funds for the purpose of acquiring a Dive Team truck. According to the Department, those funds will be sufficient for this project. Additional operating and maintenance costs will be absorbed within the Department's current and future base budget. This truck will not be included in the Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund. Any future replacement purchase would be expected to be made with non-tax levy funding.
