

Sex Offender Release



The Waukesha County Sheriff's Department and the City of Waukesha Police Department have been working with the Department of Corrections-Probation and Parole Office regarding the anticipated release of ADAM S. HETKE (M/W DOB 03/15/1989) to the community. HETKE will be released on Tuesday, 1/26/16. HETKE has no permanent residence at this time and upon release he will be taken to the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department for face-to-face registration. HETKE will be a lifetime sex offender registrant and also on GPS monitoring. If he violates the terms of his lifetime registry or GPS conditions, he will be taken back into custody.

HETKE is considered a serious offender with a high probability to reoffend. HETKE'S conviction was in 2007 for a 2nd degree sexual assault involving the use of force. This offense was committed against an adult female staff member at a facility that he was being housed at. He grabbed the victim inappropriately and attempted to remove her clothing, however, the victim was able to escape his grip and get away. We want to make sure that the community remains vigilant and ensure they fully understand the seriousness of this offender, especially since he will not have permanent housing upon release. He will be required to make regular contact with his assigned agent, advising them of his locations. This will also be verified through the use of GPS.

Mr. HETKE has served the prison sentence imposed on him by the courts. **He is not wanted by the police at this time. This notification is not intended to increase fear, rather, it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public.**

Sex offenders **have always** lived in our communities; but it wasn't until Act 440 (June 1997) that law enforcement is now able to share this information with the community. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Please understand that such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community
