

NEWS RELEASE

July 11, 2016

On Monday, July 11, 2016, at 3:08pm the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department along with the Pewaukee Fire Department responded to an accident on Redford Blvd. and Watertown Rd. involving a semi-truck and a bicycle.

Upon investigation it was determined that the semi-truck was traveling westbound on CTH M/Watertown Rd. and was making a right turn to go northbound on CTH F/Redford Blvd. The bicyclist was traveling westbound on Watertown Rd and traveled into the path of the semi-truck as it was making the right turn. The male operator of the bicycle was struck and killed.

The operator and sole occupant of the semi-truck was a 66-year-old male from Glendale. The operator of the bicycle was a 59-year-old male from New Berlin.

Wisconsin State Patrol will be assisting with the truck inspection and the accident remains under investigation by the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department. The intersection of Redford Blvd. and Watertown Rd. was closed for several hours.
