

What Are Sexually Transmitted Diseases

Sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) are diseases that can be passed from one person to another during all types of intimate sexual contact. Examples of STDs include chlamydia, gonorrhea, herpes, HIV and syphilis; pubic lice and genital warts are also considered STDs. Symptoms of STDs may include pain while urinating, burning, itching, sores, discharge, bumps or blisters in genital area. However, a person may be infected with an STD and not have symptoms.

Who Can Attend the STD/HIV Clinic

The STD/HIV clinic is available to anyone seeking confidential counseling, testing and treatment of STDs. The clinic is available by appointment only, and the fee is \$40; however, no one is turned away for inability to pay. Please call the Public Health Division at 262-896-8450 to schedule an appointment.

The Waukesha County Public Health Division STD/HIV Clinic, mentioned on the left, provides confidential counseling, testing and treatment for the following:


- Syphilis – Chlamydia
